Preventive Care

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) provides for certain preventive services to be covered 100 percent when received by participating providers. Find the most current guidelines [HERE](#). (or visit <https://www.healthcare.gov/coverage/preventive-care-benefits/>)

Preventive services are those provided when no symptoms or diagnosed medical conditions exist. For services to be covered as preventive, your doctor must bill claims with preventive codes. If a preventive service identifies a condition that needs further testing or treatment, regular copayments, coinsurance, or deductibles may apply.

Here are some some preventive services covered with no patient cost:

- Routine physical exam
- Routine vision exam
- Routine hearing exam
- Routine gynecological exam
- Routine Pap smear
- Screening mammogram
- Screening colonoscopy or Cologuard
- FDA-approved contraception

Immunizations

Immunizations recommended by the Center for Disease Controls and Prevention (CDC) are covered 100 percent if received from a participating provider.

Vaccine	CDC Recommendations*
Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pregnant women (between 32-36 weeks) • Adults 60+
COVID-19	All persons 6 mo.+
Poliovirus (IPV)	Adults
Influenza	All persons 6 mo.+

Getting screening tests regularly may find breast, cervical, and colorectal (colon) cancers early, when treatment is likely to work best. Lung cancer screening is recommended for some people who are at high risk.
